

The Palisades High School Music Buddies Club features talented high school music students who are interested in offering free music coaching to elementary music students.

The club was founded and organized by Pali High students as a way to support current elementary music students by providing free music lessons while receiving community service hours for their efforts.

The program provides free lessons for kids who might otherwise not get private lessons, serves as a supplement for kids who want someone to help them practice and provides a mentorship opportunity between high school and elementary musicians.

All of the lessons take place via Zoom.

Instruments offered include piano/keyboard, violin, cello, ukulele, flute, clarinet, saxophone, and trumpet.

Parents can reach out directly to the high school student to arrange a Zoom lesson time.

Parents must agree to login on time to the Zoom lesson and must remain present throughout the lesson with their child to offer help and support.
